Measures for the Division of Labor and Responsibility for Railway Rivers and Dams (Approved by the Financial and Economic Committee of the Government Council Issued by the Ministry of Railways on January 25, 1952)

- (1) In principle, all repairs or new construction of dams shall be undertaken by the various units of the Ministry of Water Resources.
- (2) The Ministry of Railways and the Ministry of Water Resources jointly inspect each autumn, and if there are projects that should be repaired or newly built, those within the construction scope of the water conservancy project plan will be included in the plan by the Ministry of Water Resources, and they are not within the construction scope of the water conservancy plan, and the projects necessary to protect the railway should be included in the plan by the Ministry of Water Resources and be responsible for the construction after the two ministries jointly submit a petition to the Finance Committee for approval while submitting annual control figure opinions.
- (3) If the railway has to assist in the rescue due to dam failure or emergency congestion, the special funds needed are allowed to be temporarily advanced in the operating expenses of the railway, and then the two ministries will jointly request the special funds for the advance.
