Attendance:

More than 110 people attended the meeting, including representatives of aquatic institutions, fishermen, aquatic enterprises, aquatic educators and relevant units of the central government, including the people's governments of Northeast China, East China, Central and South Regions, Hebei Province and Tianjin Municipality.

Other Decisions and/or Actions:

The meeting pointed out that in 1950 the country's aquatic industry had been restored considerably, and the production tasks set by the first National Fisheries Conference in February 1950 had been exceeded. In 1951, the national aquatic production policy was still mainly based on recovery, and the production task was set at 1.1 million tons, an increase of 20% compared with 1950, and strive to recover to 1.5 million tons before the Anti-Japanese War within two years. The meeting held that in order to ensure the smooth completion of the production task in 1951, it was necessary to do the following work:

1. Vigorously assist fishermen in organizing fishery mutual aid groups and cooperatives, and guide individual fishermen to the road of collective production of mutual assistance and cooperation;
2. Organize the transportation and marketing of fish products in a planned manner;
3. Strengthen the business management of state-owned aquatic enterprises;
4. Strengthen the management of fish markets in various places;
5. Aquatic administrative agencies at all levels should strengthen investigation and research to understand the overall situation of aquatic resources in various districts.
