

## **Notice of the Central Committee on Focusing on the Use of Radio Stations and Radio Networks to Promote Work**

### ***All central bureaus and branches are transferred to provincial and municipal party committees:***

On March 29, Tianjin organized 500,000 citizens to listen to the radio broadcast of the suppression of the counter-revolution, and within three hours, the radio station received more than 600 letters and more than 4,000 phone calls, expressing their enthusiastic support. The details have been broadcast nationwide by Xinhua News Agency. Shanghai also had a similar experience when welcoming the report of the representatives of the Volunteer Army. This proves that radio stations and their radio networks can play a greater educational role in the political life of urban people. It is hoped that in the future, all cities with radio stations will focus on using radio stations and radio networks to promote work and educate the people.
