

Provisions of the Ministry of Public Security of the Central People's Government on the Measures for the Release of Public Security News

Recently, some newspapers have published cases of cracking spies, which have not been reviewed by the responsible comrades and have not been approved by their superiors. In order to avoid loopholes and effectively attack the enemy, the following provisions are made regarding the release of public security news:

- (1) The release of news must have a clear purpose. Not all cases can be published, and not all cases must be published. This can not only achieve the effect of educating the masses, but also avoid exposing secrets.
- (2) All political cases involving reactionaries in the democratic parties, imperialist spies (the former involves united front issues, the latter involves international relations and is related to the development of the entire international situation), and other political cases with national origin must be reported to the Central Public Security Ministry and approved before they can be published.
- (3) Where a large administrative region publishes a political case involving other administrative regions, it shall also be reported to the Central Ministry of Public Security for approval.
- (4) All political cases involving provinces and cities within the Grand Administrative Region shall be reviewed and approved by the Ministry of Public Security of the Grand Administrative Region.
- (5) Provinces and municipalities directly under the central government shall report to the Central Ministry of Public Security for approval if they involve other provinces, municipalities or large administrative regions.
- (6) All cases published by local localities shall be reviewed in advance by the responsible comrades of the local public security departments, and the important cases shall be reviewed and approved by the Party committee at the same level.
