

## **Instructions from the Central Committee of the CCP on Forwarding Jia Tuofu's Report on the "Five-Anti" Campaign in Xi'an**

*(March 25, 1952)*

To all Central Bureaus and Sub-Bureaus for transmission to provincial, municipal, and regional Party committees:

1. **Comrade Jia Tuofu's report** on the "Five-Anti" campaign in Xi'an is a good one and is being circulated to all localities as a reference and model to follow.
2. In the course of the "Five-Anti" campaign, the **municipal Party committee**, the **district Party committees**, and all the forces they lead should divide their **work focus into two phases**:
  - **In the first phase, 80% of efforts** should be directed toward clarifying the situation of **approximately 95% of industrial and commercial households**, i.e., the **first three categories** of such households, and drawing conclusions. This phase should aim to form a **united front for the "Five-Anti" campaign**. Only **20% of efforts** should be devoted to handling the **last two categories** of households during this period.
  - **In the second phase**, the focus should be **reversed: 80% of the work** should target the **last two categories** of households, while the remaining **20%** should be used to resolve the remaining issues with the **first three categories**.

Under no circumstances should this order be **reversed**, as doing so would lead to delays, prevent the **rapid formation of a united front** for the campaign, and **delay the restoration of normal economic life**. All localities are urged to **pay close attention** to this point.
