Cultivating a Large Number of New Intellectuals

The GAC of the Central People's Government Decides Renmin University to Enrol Industrial Workers; Relevant Government Ministries and the All-China Federation of Trade Unions Determine Quotas for Each Region

[Xinhua News Agency, Beijing, 5th] The Ministry of Heavy Industry, the Ministry of Fuel Industry, the Ministry of Textile Industry, the Ministry of Light Industry, the Ministry of Railways, the Ministry of Posts and Telecommunications, the Ministry of Communications, and the All-China

Federation of Trade Unions of the Central People's Government issued a joint notice on the 3rd of this month, allocating quotas for workers from various regions and industries to study at Renmin University of China this term. The full text of the notice is as follows: In order to cultivate a large number of new intellectuals and meet the needs of national construction, the GAC of the Central People's Government has decided that Renmin University of China will enrol a portion of its staff this term to cultivate backbone personnel for various national construction departments. The All-China

Federation of Trade Unions and the Ministry of Heavy Industry of the Central People's Government, among other departments, have jointly discussed and allocated quotas for each region as follows: Northeast: 80 workers from heavy industry, 20 workers from light industry, 60 workers from fuel industry, 10 workers from textile industry, 30 workers from railways, 10 workers from transportation, and 9 workers from post and telecommunications, totalling 219.

North China: 70 employees in heavy industry, 20 in light industry, 50 in fuel industry, 35 in textile industry, 20 in railway, 16 in transportation, and 9 in postal and telecommunications, totalling 220.

Northwest China: 10 employees in heavy industry, 5 in light industry, 10 in fuel industry, 10 in textile industry, and 5 in transportation, totalling 40.

East China: 20 employees in heavy industry, 30 in light industry, 35 in fuel industry, 50 in textile industry, 10 in railway, 20 in transportation, and 9 in postal and telecommunications, totalling 174.

Central and Southern China: 25 employees in heavy industry, 15 in light industry, 20 in fuel industry, 20 in textile industry, 10 in railway, and 20 in transportation, totalling 110.

A total of 205 employees from heavy industry, 90 from light industry, 175 from fuel industry, 125 from textile industry, 70 from railways, 71 from transportation, and 27 from postal and telecommunications, totalling 763 across all industries nationwide, are requested to apply.

Local authorities are required to recommend labor heroes, model workers, skilled workers, and employees with management experience for admission.

In addition to the requirements stipulated in the admission guidelines, we request that local authorities recommend labor heroes, model workers, active participants in production, skilled workers, and employees with management experience. This recruitment will primarily focus on major industrial sectors. Local administrative departments and trade unions are requested to jointly

assist the schools in their recruitment efforts and ensure the allocation of places to each region is fulfilled. Besides the allocated places, if any workers or employees wish to apply to other undergraduate departments, the administrative departments and trade unions are responsible for making introductions.
