Resolution of the CPC Central Committee on the Implementation of Planned Procurement and Planned Supply of Grain.

**Remarks:**

Mao Zedong reviewed and revised the draft resolution of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of China on implementing planned grain procurement and planned supply.

In the second part of the draft resolution, after the sentence "This is not only because the peasants have received reasonable grain prices and benefited from price stability, but more importantly, it is because only by taking the path of mutual assistance and cooperation, the path of socialism, can the peasants finally escape poverty," the following is added: "Only by leading a life that becomes increasingly prosperous year by year can the commercial grain market increase significantly to meet the needs of both urban and rural residents."

In the sixth section, after the sentence "They must understand the Party's general line and general tasks in the transition period," add: "That is, within approximately three five-year plans, or about fifteen years, we must build our country into a great socialist country and make the transition from New Democracy to socialism."

At the same time, he drafted a notice for the Central Committee: "We are sending you the 'Resolution of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of China on Implementing Planned Grain Procurement and Supply'. Please implement it conscientiously. In addition to being promptly distributed to county and urban district committees, it can also be published in party publications."
